#### ABOUT THE ARTISTS

**Wanda Sobieska** is a violinist in the northeast Ohio area. Recent and upcoming engagements include the Ashland Symphony, Tuscarawas Philharmonic, Porthouse Theater at Blossom, Saint Paul's Lutheran Church in Massillon, Warren Philharmonic, The Cleveland Opera, and Bluewater Kings Band.

Notably, she has been a returning soloist for the Youngstown New Music Guild Series; has provided arrangements for San Francisco Chamber Orchestra, English Symphony Orchestra, and Metropolitan Opera; and runs freegigmusic.com, a sheet music website serving musicians from all over the world with 1000 visitors a day.

Born in Warsaw, Poland, she is the fifth generation in a family of musicians and musicologists. She is actively involved in her family's opera company, The Cleveland Opera. Wanda holds a Bachelor of Music in violin performance from the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music.

Julian Sobieski has been involved in *The Cleveland* Opera-his family's opera company-for nearly two decades, performing in over forty opera choruses since early childhood. He plays double bass for company performances and in chamber ensembles. In addition to frequenting church services as a bassist and singer, his most recent engagement was with *The Cleveland Opera* in the instrumental ensemble for the Polish comic opera, *Echo in the Woods*, by Józef Elsner.

Julian is a graduate of Kent State University, where he pursued a double major in chemistry and physics and a minored in philosophy. He is currently completing his doctoral degree in chemistry at Carnegie-Mellon University.

**Chad Pittman** is a full-time musician--conductor, educator and organist--who believes in the amazing transformational power of music. Active as a presenter and clinician in the greater Ohio choral community and beyond, he is the newly appointed Director of Choruses for the Canton Symphony Orchestra.

Chad is also Director of Choirs for Northwest High School, in Stark County, where he administers an active choral program of seven choirs, serves as Music Director of the annual musical, and assists at Northwest Middle School.

Chad serves as Director of Music and Organist for St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church in Massillon, where he leads the ensembles, facilitates a weekly program of guest artists in worship, and coordinates *Cathedral Concerts in the Evening*, the church's newly established professional concert series.

Chad is co-founder of *Two Men and a Bench*, a traveling organ duo, with duet partner Mark Thewes. Since 2013, the two have presented concerts in churches and concert halls across the country. He is also active in the *Paderewski Duo*, a collaboration with violinist, Wanda Sobieska.

Born in North Carolina and raised in northeast Ohio, Chad is currently a doctoral student in music education at Kent State University and studies in the summer Choral Conducting program at Michigan State University. He holds the Master of Educational Administration from Cleveland State University and a Bachelor of Music Education and Organ from the Baldwin Wallace University Conservatory of Music.
