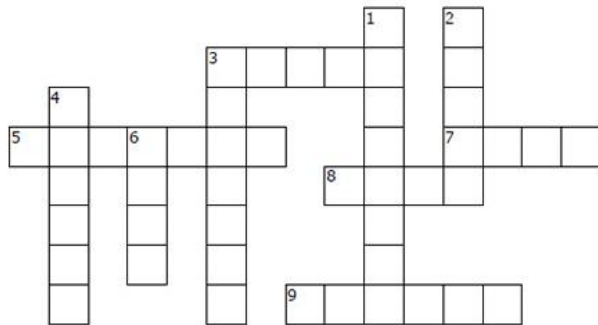


CROSSWORD PUZZLE
